The Einstein - in the Heart of St.Gallen

The five-story building was constructed in 1830 by the widow of the textile manufacturer Jacob Allgäuer and then operated as a finishing shop. After several changes of ownership, Isaak David Einstein acquired the building and produced his embroideries there. In 1978, the textile manufacturer Max Kriemler acquired the building and opened the privately run Hotel Einstein St.Gallen in 1983.

The stylish 4* Superior Hotel Einstein St.Gallen is located in the heart of the city of St.Gallen in a quiet location. It is situated directly next to the pedestrian zone and between the world-famous UNESCO monastery quarter of the Old Town and the Red Square. The hotel is within five minutes walking distance from St.Gallen train station. The rooms and suites, renovated with attention to detail, are furnished with cherry wood and have pleasant pastel colors.
